ACCOUNTABILITY CIRCLES

This 12 session program is for referred youth who would benefit from group meetings. A skilled Circle Keeper guides the dialogue and offers a curriculum that allows the youth to share their story, discover important life skills and techniques to make better decisions, learn about empathy, compassion, respect and other critical values, and learn to apologize and make things right.

Every youth will have an individual Restorative Conference which is the heart of the program. All conference participants will create a Restorative Action Plan with the youth designed to repair the harm that was caused by their actions. Restorative Resources staff will support and hold the youth accountable as they complete their plan to successfully finish the program.
